Applicant must be a female student pilot or pilot working towards a sport pilot or higher rating with a qualified C.F.I. Applicant must have soloed; be a high school senior or older; and, reside in Delaware or a member of the Delaware Chapter 99s.

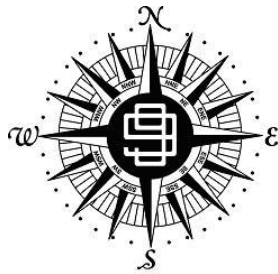

## **Delaware Chapter of the 99's, Inc.**

### **Scholarship Criteria**

1. Applicant must be female.
2. Applicant must reside in Delaware, or be a member of the Delaware Chapter of the 99's.
3. Applicant must be at least a senior in high school at the time of application. There is no upper age limit.
4. Applicant must be working towards a sport pilot or higher rating.
5. Applicant must have soloed.
6. Applicant must sign the application, and if under 18, parent(s) must also sign.
7. The award must be used for flight time towards the rating specified in the application.
8. Applicant must submit a Letter of Recommendation from her flight instructor.

### **Expectations for Scholarship Winner**

If not currently a Delaware Chapter and/or 99s member, winner must join the 99s and the Delaware Chapter for a minimum of one (1) year.

Winner is required to attend at least two (2) Delaware Chapter meetings.

The award money must be used within one year (365 days) of presentation. All unused portions will be refunded to the Delaware Chapter.

On completion of the use of the scholarship money, winners are required to present a report in writing or verbally to the Chapter regarding their accomplishments.

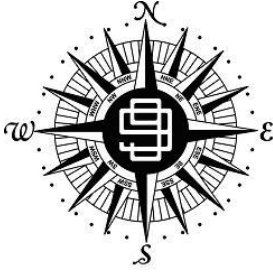
